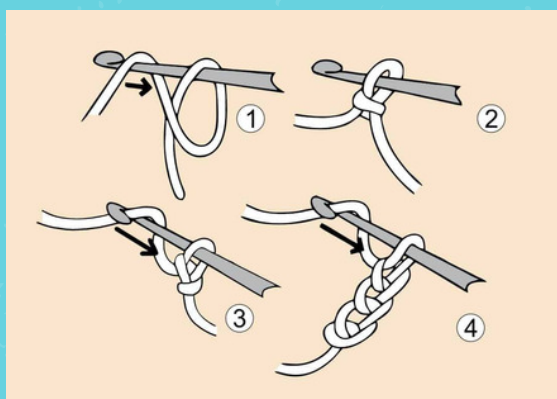


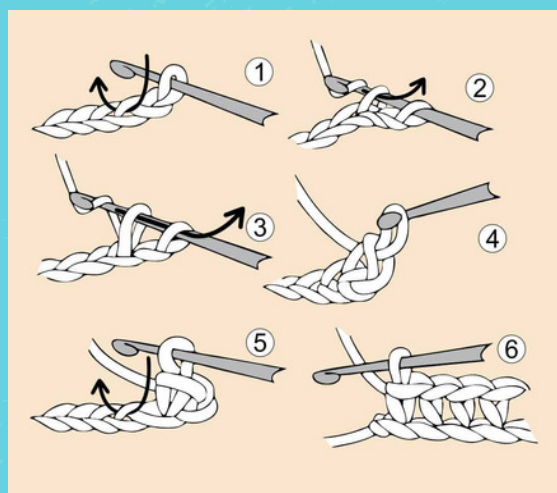
HOW TO CROCHET AN EASY SCARF

You are going to rock your homemade scarf! When people see you wearing it and ask how you got so crafty, tell them:
"I ate a lot of paste as a kid".



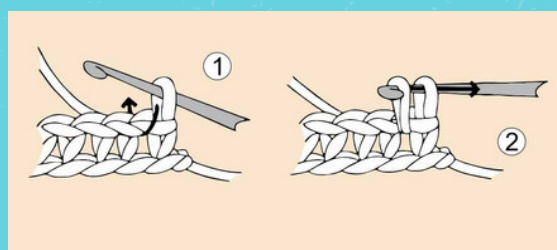
Chain

Use your hook to pull the yarn through the loop (1) and pull the loop until it's tight (2)...but not too tight...just right tight...Confused? Me too. Wrap the yarn over the hook from back to front. Pull hook, bringing the yarn through the loop on your hook (3). Do this over and over again until you die (or until you have the length of the scarf you want).



Single Crochet

Insert the hook into the second chain from hook (1) and wrap yarn over the hook and pull through the first loop on your hooky thingy (2). Now wrap the yarn over the hook again and pull through both loops (3). You did something (4). Insert the hook again into the next chain and repeat until you die (or you're at the end of your rope...literally (5, 6).



Slip Stitch

This is how you finish your scarf off (so it doesn't all unravel and make you cry) or transition to another color if you want to...no pressure. Insert your hook into the next stitch (1). Wrap yarn over and draw through all loops at once (2).
Congratulations! You are crocheting like a boss!
